Abdul Hamid al-Ghizzawi has serious health problems but is being held in the harshest facility in Guantánamo. There are fears for his life.

Abdul al-Ghizzawi is in Camp 6, where detainees are held in extreme isolation and suffer other forms of sensory deprivation. In September 2006 he learned that he had hepatitis B and tuberculosis. Despite this, US authorities have refused calls to move him to a less harsh facility.

ACT NOW

- Urge that Abdul Hamid al-Ghizzawi be given regular access to an independent doctor and provided with all the appropriate medical treatment he needs.
- Ask that he be transferred immediately to less harsh facilities, and given a fair trial or released.
