BURUNDIEtienne MVUYEKURE, Geological engineer, former Secretary General of the Rassemblement du peuple burundais (RPB), Rally for Burundi People, a political opposition party

On 16 December 1997, Amnesty International expressed concern for the safety of Etienne Mvuyekure who was arrested on 1 or 2 November 1997 and to whom all access had been denied since 10 November 1997. Amnesty International, which has not yet received a response to its earlier appeal, is seriously concerned for his physical integrity.

Amnesty International has received new information that Etienne Mvuyekure was not in fact transferred to Mpimba Central Prison, as previously stated. Sources at the *bataillon para* (commando) military camp are also reported to have stated that Etienne Mvuyekure is no longer held at the camp and that he has been released. He has not been seen since.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes (no mail to Burundi) in French or in your own language:

- expressing concern for the safety of Etienne Mvuyekure, arrested on 1 or 2 November 1997;

- calling on the authorities to immediately establish and make public the whereabouts of Etienne Mvuyekure;

- calling on the authorities to bring to justice, in accordance with international standards of fairness, officials who are found to have carried out or condoned human rights violations.
