# Further Information on UA 07/03 (AFR 27/001/2003, 09 January 2003) <u>Incommunicado detention / Fear of torture or ill-treatment</u>

#### **GAMBIA**

"Mubarak" (m), Moroccan national

According to independent reports from Banjul, "Mubarak" was released in mid-January 2003, and given one day to leave the country. His current whereabouts are unknown.

"Mubarak" was arrested on 30 December 2002 and found to be in possession of a false passport. He was held in incommunicado detention at the headquarters of the Gambian National Intelligence agency. He was reportedly questioned by both the National Intelligence Agency and US investigators on any links he might have with al-Qa'ida. Amnesty International had expressed concern for his safety.

The order to leave the country is thought to be linked to his alleged false passport.

## RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send appeals to arrive as quickly as possible, in English or your own language:

- seeking confirmation of the release of Mubarak in mid-Janaury:
- requesting confirmation of the order for him to leave the country;
- however, if Mubarak is still in detention, calling on the authorities to reveal his whereabouts and the reasons for his arrest and continued detention;
- if he is still in detention, calling for him to be given immediate access to medical care, legal counsel and humanitarian and human rights groups.
