## EL SALVADOR: Adolfo AGUILAR PAYÉS, sociology student

Amnesty International has learned that Adolfo Aguilar Payés, a political prisoner on hunger strike since mid-October, has been transferred to hospital under prison guard and is receiving adequate medical attention. He is also allowed visits from his lawyer and relatives.

He is on hunger strike to protest having been held for more than three years without trial. He was arrested and tortured by Treasury Police in July 1989, accused of the murder of two members of a right-wing group. The only evidence against him appears to be an extrajudicial statement drawn up by the Treasury Police.

Amnesty International has learned that the judge has called for the jury trial to commence on 24 November 1992.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express and airmail letters, either in Spanish, English or your own language:

- expressing concern that Adolfo Aguilar Payés has been held without trial since 1989 and noting that he has been on hunger strike since mid-October 1992;

- noting that he has been transferred to hospital and requesting information about his current medical state;

- urging that he be given a prompt and impartial trial in accordance with internationally-recognized standards;

- expressing concern that the only evidence against him appears to be an extrajudicial statement which he was forced to sign without being able to read it;

- requesting full investigations into his allegations of torture and reported irregularities in the legal proceedings against him.
