On 1 November 1997 Antonio Aguilar Hernández reappeared after he was set free in a street in Los Reyes, La Paz, Mexico State. He reportedly suffered torture during the two months that he was "disappeared". No further harassment has been reported towards his family.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or in your own language:

- calling for measures to be taken to ensure the safety of Antonio Aguilar Hernández and his family;
- urging a prompt and thorough investigation into his reported abduction and torture by members of the Mexican security forces, and for those responsible to be brought to justice.
