Amnesty International has received further information on the above members of a group of lawyers calling themselves the Ad Hoc Legal Observation Delegation.

Anne-Marie Parodi and Martin Heiming have now left Peru. However, Heriberto Ocasio remains in Peru and there therefore continues to be fears for his physical safety.

Heriberto Ocasio was reportedly physically attacked in the street by unidentified people dressed in civilian clothing on 5 October 1992.

The lawyers and their translator went to Lima, the capital, with the intention of observing and reporting on the trial of Abimael Guzmán, leader of the Partido Comunista del Perú (Sendero Luminoso), PCP, Communist Party of Peru (Shining Path).

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/express and airmail letters:

- urging the authorities to take all the necessary steps to guarantee the physical safety of Heriberto Ocasio.
