PAKISTAN

Mohammad Ali (m) aged 45

Amnesty International has learnt that Mohammad Ali was hanged at dawn on 30 October at the district jail in Jhang city, in western Punjab province. President Musharaff rejected his application for a stay of execution.

Mohammad Ali was convicted of murdering a man called Fayyaz Ahmad in 1996. He was sentenced to death in May 2000 and his appeal was rejected by the High Court in 2004; his second and final appeal was rejected by the Supreme Court.
