## TURKEYAy\_e Yeter Kaz\_m Bak\_\_\_\_ about 100 taken into detention Emine Ocak and Ali Ocak

Ay\_e Yeter, Lawyer Kele\_ Öztürk, Kaz\_m Bak\_, president of Limter\_ union, and seven others lodged formal complaints with the Eyüp State Prosecutor against the Governor of Istanbul, the Director and Deputy Directors of Istanbul Police and the police officers on duty on 7 March 2000. In their complaints they stated that while they were being arrested they were beaten by the officials on duty that day on the instructions of the Director and Deputy Directors of Police. Some of them sustained injuries as a result of being beaten and these injuries were documented in medical reports of which Amnesty International has received copies. The forensic report for Lawyer Kele\_ Öztürk issued on 7 March 2000 recorded 'a laceration on the left upper eyelid ... a linear abrasion measuring 3 x 4 cm on the anteriomedian of the left thigh'.

Special team and anti-riot police officers on the buses taking them to Istanbul Police Headquarters also reportedly told them that they were traitors like Süleyman Yeter and that they would kill them as they had killed Süleyman Yeter.

On 18 May the Eyüp State Prosecutor informed them that he had decided not to open an investigation into their complaint. They appealed against his decision on 2 June and the appeal has been sent to Beyo lu Penal Court for investigation.

In the meantime, a case has been opened against these individuals and others for holding an illegal demonstration on 7 March 2000.
