Amnesty International launches briefing on war-era sexual violence in Bosnia and Herzegovina

On 29 March, Amnesty International will use a press conference in Sarajevo to release a briefing exposing the failure of successive governments in Bosnia and Herzegovina to ensure thousands of women and girls raped during the 1992-1995 war justice, truth and reparation.
