

Israel/OT: Further information on Children under siege. (Web action WA 07/2003, MDE 15/103/2003)

Thank you to those who responded to our appeal for action on “Children under siege” on the occasion of International Children’s Day 2003. This action focused on the impact movement restrictions in the Occupied Territories have had on Palestinian children, linked to Amnesty International’s report on the issue of movement restrictions imposed by the Israeli army on Palestinians living in the Occupied Territories.

Unfortunately, the situation remains unchanged, and Amnesty International remains concerned about the effect these movement restrictions have on children’s health, education, and general well-being.
