## PALESTINIAN AUTHORITYFathi Subuh, 43, lecturer in education

Concern for the health and well-being of prisoner of conscience Fathi Subuh has been heightened by reports that he remains on hunger-strike in protest at his arrest. According to his family, he received visits from the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), who reported that he has been on hunger-strike for a total of 24 days, taking only sugared water and coffee. He is said to be suffering from "back inflammation" and headache.

The 43-year-old university assistant professor of education, arrested on 2 July 1997, has now been held for more than a month in Tel al-Hawa Prison in Gaza without access to his family nor to his lawyers. He is now apparently in the prison's clinic.

## Please continue action, ie telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in English, Arabic or in your own language. Any further appeals should:

- state that you consider Fathi Subuh to be a prisoner of conscience, detained solely for his alleged critical attitude towards the Palestinian Authority; note that Fathi Subuh has now been illegally held for more than a month in incommunicado detention;
- request that he be granted immediate access to his family and a lawyer and to a doctor of his choice;
- call for his immediate and unconditional release.
