## UNITED ARAB EMIRATESSarah Balabagan (f), Filipina national

According to a press report, the prison authorities have begun to carry out the flogging sentence against Sarah Balabagan. No further details are available at present.

On 15 September 1995, Sarah Balabagan was found guilty of the premeditated murder of her employer, Almas Mohammed al-Baloushi. During her trial before the court of first instance she stated that she had stabbed him to death because he had raped her. Her defence lawyer argued for her acquittal on the basis of self-defence, but the court found her guilty as charged and sentenced her to death.

On 30 October 1995, an appeal court in Al-Ain sentenced Sarah Balabagan to one year's imprisonment and 100 lashes. It quashed the death sentence verdict passed by the court of first instance on 15 September 1995, and ordered her to pay 150,000 dirhams (US\$41,000) blood money to relatives of Almas Mohammed al-Baloushi, who was stabbed to death by the defendant.

Amnesty International considers the judicial punishment of flogging to be contrary to Article 5 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which states "no-one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment".
