Fuad 'Ali Mohsen al-Shahari (m), aged about 45

Fuad 'Ali Mohsen al-Shahari was executed by firing squad on the morning of 29 November. His son was with him during the execution, in Taiz, and told Amnesty International afterwards that the family thanked the organization "for all your efforts and standing by Fuad and with us".

Amnesty International campaigned tirelessly on behalf of Fuad al-Shahari for over nine years, and appealed continually to the President to commute the death sentence, right up until Fuad al-Shahari was executed.

No further action is requested from the UA network. Many thanks to all who sent appeals on Fuad 'Ali Mohsen al-Shahari's behalf.
