ALL I WANT IS TO BE EDUCATED

Though the Bangladeshi government agreed to a plan to educate Rohingya children, they still do not have a voice in most decisions related to them. For decades the Rohingya refugees have been subjected to repression and discrimination in Myanmar. They must not suffer more to be able to speak up for their rights.

Every year, Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh take dangerous boat journeys in hope of a better life in another country. Many refugees perish after being stranded in the sea for weeks or even months without food.

HOPE ... TO BE ABLE TO EARN A LIVING

ALL I WANT IS TO BE ABLE TO PROVIDE FOR MY FAMILY, TO KEEP FOOD ON THEIR TABLE

Rohingya men, women and children risk their lives by taking deadly boat journeys to other countries in the hope of a better future. They are faced with dire consequences of perishing in the sea or being detained if they survive.

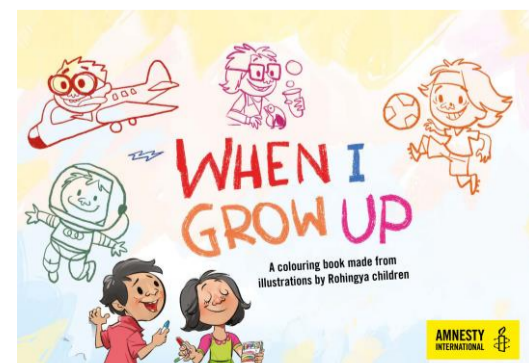
