Amnesty International report launch: *Invisible Victims: Migrants on the Move in Mexico*

Press Conference Invite

Amnesty International is launching a report in Mexico on the abuses faced by tens of thousands of women, men and children every year, who without legal permission try to cross the country on their way to the US border, which takes them on one of the most dangerous journeys in the world.

The report, which will be made public at a press conference on 28 April in Mexico City, details the challenges facing the migrants, including extortion, beatings, sexual violence, abduction and murder. Private security guards, migration officials, police, military, people traffickers and criminal gangs all take part in the abuse.
