Israel/Occupied Territories/Palestinian Authority: Amnesty International delegation visiting Gaza

As part of the on-going campaign to stop the killing of civilians on both sides, an Amnesty International delegation will be visiting Gaza today and tomorrow, and Jerusalem on Thursday. This visit is in connection with the release of a new report "Without distinction: attacks on civilians by Palestinian armed groups".

By releasing its report in Gaza, the organization aims to contribute to the emerging debate in Palestinian civil society condemning attacks against civilians. Amnesty International welcomes Palestinian voices who unreservedly condemned attacks on Israeli civilians .

The delegates include Daniel Bolomey, Director of Amnesty International's Swiss section, and Abdel Salam Sidahmed; deputy Director of the Middle East Program and Liz Hodgkin, researcher in the Middle East Program at the International Secretariat. They will be meeting with leaders and representatives of Palestinian armed groups, non-governmental organizations and human rights activists.

The delegates will be available for interviews on Wednesday evening and on Thursday morning and early afternoon.
