A journalist who exposed corruption at a state bank has been attacked by a man who threatened to kill her and two of her colleagues.

Sylvia Gereda, a journalist with the newspaper *elPeriódico*, was attacked on the evening of 27 March as she left Del Valle university, where she is studying. Her assailant seized her by the neck and said he would kill her and her colleagues Luis Escobar and Enrique Castañeda if they wrote any more articles about the *Banco de Crédito Hipotecario Nacional* (CHN).

Sylvia Gereda and her colleagues have exposed official corruption and irregularities at the CHN, apparently related to loans granted by the bank to companies with close links to them.

Sylvia had already been warned that the bank's president had ordered somebody to watch her and her colleagues. On 28 March Enrique Castañeda was followed by a red pick-up truck on his way to work at *elPeriódico*.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

*ElPeriódico* has recently come under attack from supporters of the government. On 20 February a group of supporters of the ruling *Frente Republicano Guatemalteco* (FRG) party demonstrated outside the newspaper's offices after it published articles questioning the policies of Communications Minister Luis Rabbé. Staff of the newspaper *Prensa Libre* have also been intimidated for criticising the current administration and its policies.

During 2000 a number of Guatemalan journalists were harassed and received death threats, in particular those who had been outspoken in their criticism of the authorities (see UA 23/01, UA 212/00, AMR 34/30/00, 13 July 2000 and UA 142/00, AMR 34/18/00, 31 May 2000).

These threats come at a time of escalating political and social tensions in Guatemala. Last year, human rights defenders in Guatemala were increasingly the target of threats, and the Guatemalan authorities did nothing to effectively investigate or prevent this harassment.

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish, English or your own language:**

- urging the authorities to take immediate and effective measures to protect Sylvia Gereda, Luis Escobar and Enrique Castañeda;
- calling for an immediate and thorough investigation into the reported death threats against these journalists, and for those responsible to be brought to justice;
- expressing concern for the safety of all those working to protect human rights and freedom of expression, particularly those who have recently faced threats and intimidation, including journalists at *el Periódico* and *Prensa Libre*.
