Samer Fawzi 'Awartani is no longer in solitary confinement.

His administrative detention order will be submitted for approval by a military judge on 17 June.

- asking for Samer Fawzi 'Awartani to be released immediately, if he is not to be charged with a recognisably criminal offence and given a fair and prompt trial.
