PUBLIC EVENTS PLANNED IN CAPE TOWN: 11 TO 14 NOVEMBER

The Amnesty International delegation, led by Secretary General Pierre Sané, finishes its high-level visit to South Africa with several public events in Capetown. Among the scheduled activities of the delegation are:

- Saturday, 11 November -- Speech on foreign policy.

A public meeting will be addressed by Mr Sané on the theme of "Foreign policy and South Africa's role in the protection of human rights". - Sunday, 12 November -- Beach walk, interfaith service, press briefing.

- Tuesday, 14 November -- Final Press Conference.
