Amnesty International has received further information on the above 24 people who were reportedly detained by the police on 11 and 12 June 1992 in Lima and whose detention was unacknowledged at that time.

Amnesty International has now learned that the authorities have recognized the detention of the above named people, all of whom are still being held at the Dirección Nacional Contra el Terrorismo, DINCOTE, the anti-terrorist police headquarters. The information received also indicates that the detainees may be charged with offences related to terrorism, but the precise nature of the charges is not yet known.

Amnesty International has also now received conflicting evidence as to whether the ten unnamed persons are being held in detention or not.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters

- asking that the above named persons, whose detention has been recognized, either be promptly brought before a judge and charged with a recognizable criminal offence or released immediately;

- requesting that the authorities make available the names of any other persons detained on 12 June on entering the Patria Libre building;

- urging that all the detainees held in custody be humanely treated, and given access to independent lawyers, doctors, relatives and a representative from the Public Ministry.
