HAITI:Evans Paul

Amnesty International has received information that although Evans Paul is still in need of medical treatment, as a result of the beatings he sustained while in military custody on 7 October 1991, his situation is not now considered life-threatening. He has indicated, therefore, that he is not now seeking to leave the country for medical treatment abroad.

Evans Paul has expressed his deep appreciation for the large demonstration of concern for his safety, and asked that our efforts continue on behalf of victims of human rights violations arising out of the coup d'Etat.

No further action is requested at this time.
