Guantanamo - Amnesty International global protests mark 5 year anniversary

Marking five years since the first transfer of prisoners to Guantanamo Bay, Amnesty International is planning a series of events across the world to demand the immediate closure of the detention centre. These include:

In the USA... In Washington DC at 10:30 (local time) a press conference will be followed by a rally, co-hosted by the Center for Constitutional Rights, on the steps of the U.S Supreme Court

In the UK... Guantanamo Bay camp will be recreated outside the US embassy in London. Hundreds of people in orange boiler suits will be kneeling in the "stress" position, patrolled by uniform-clad "US guards" with large dogs on leashes.
