Viet Nam: Exclusive video interview with Dr Nguyen Dan Que

As Viet Nam marks the 1945 August Revolution on 19 August, Amnesty International is publishing a feature article and video on one the country's most distinguished human rights activists.

Dr Nguyen Dan Que has spent 19 of the past 26 years in detention for his beliefs. He is currently serving a 30-month prison sentence after publishing an article saying there was no freedom of information in Viet Nam. He is an Amnesty International member and is recognized as a prisoner of conscience. Two weeks from now, on National Day (2 September) there will be a prisoner amnesty. Amnesty International is calling for the Vietnamese authorities to use this occasion to release Dr Que.
