## SANDARA FAROUQ KADOUDA RELEASED

**Sandara Farouq Kadouda was released on 15 April. She had been abducted on 12 April by a group of men in civilian clothes, believed to belong to the National Intelligence Security Service (NISS).**

**Sandara Farouq Kadouda** was released on 15 April, three days after she had been abducted by men believed to be National Intelligence Security Service (NISS) agents. Her family told Amnesty International in a public statement that day: "Our daughter was released today, as she was kidnaped by security apparatus [NISS] on 12 April. She contacted her mother around 7:30 pm and told her that the security agents dropped her at Street 60 [in east Khartoum]". She was found in very poor health and with signs of ill treatment.
