Always, we campaign for the protection of women's rights, for women's equality with men and for women to be free from violence.

# WORK WITH US TO STOP VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

## WOMEN HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDERS

Women human rights defenders work to protect and promote their own rights, and to defend the rights of others. They are often targeted because of who they are and what they do. Governments must ensure women's right to organize without fear of repression.

---

## VIOLENCE IN THE FAMILY

Violence at home wrecks the lives of women in every country in the world. All governments should prevent domestic violence and provide respectful and supportive services.

---

## VIOLENCE IN CONFLICT

Women's lives and their bodies have been the unacknowledged casualties of conflicts for too long. We urge governments to adopt an agenda for action to ensure that perpetrators are brought to justice, either through the International Criminal Court or national justice systems.

## SAFE SCHOOLS

Women must be free to choose the path that allows them to move forward and realize their potential. Education is crucial, but violence often denies girls' their right to education. All governments must ensure that all girls have access to education free from violence.

---

## WOMEN'S RIGHTS OVER THEIR OWN BODIES

Much of the gender-based violence that men inflict on women is aimed at restricting and controlling their sexuality and reproductive capacity: from so-called "honour killings" to marital rape or the targeting of pregnant "enemy" women in conflict. We call on governments to uphold women's sexual and reproductive rights.

## TRAFFICKING IN WOMEN AND GIRLS

Many trafficked women and girls are physically and sexually abused to break them mentally and emotionally. We urge governments to punish the traffickers, not the trafficked, to identify and protect the rights of women and girls who have been trafficked, and to strengthen assistance and protection laws and practices.

## HOLDING GOVERNMENTS TO ACCOUNT

Governments have a duty to protect women from violence by state agents (such as police) and by other people, such as members of their family or community. Governments must act with due diligence to protect the rights of all women.
