## BURUNDIDoctor Sylvère SAKUBU

In September, Amnesty International raised concern for the safety of Dr Sylvère Sakubu, following his arrest on 29 August 1997, in Bujumbura, the capital. The organization has received confirmation that Dr Sakubu has now been provisionally released. He is reported to have been charged with offences relating to undermining state security (*atteinte à la sûreté de l'Etat*). He is not reported to have been tortured during his detention.
