On 18 September 1996, a court ruling on the government's appeal against the 16 July release order for Alhaji Ganiyu Dawodu, Chief Ayo Adebanjo and former Senator Abraham Adesanya (see previous update) was adjourned until 11 October. As a result, these three senior members of the National Democratic Coalition (NADECO), arrested in connection with the murder on 4 June 1996 of Alhaja Kudirat Abiola, remain in detention. Amnesty International believes that they are prisoners of conscience and continues to call for their immediate and unconditional release.

No progress has been reported in the police investigation into Kudirat Abiola's killing.

The cases of these detainees will be taken up by other parts of the Amnesty International membership, and no further action by the UA Network is requested at present. Many thanks to all who sent appeals.
