I am concerned that there have been no police investigations of human rights violations committed since 2000, including torture and killings during the 2008 elections.

I urge you to ensure investigations take place into the alleged involvement of the security forces in human rights violations. Anyone found personally responsible for human rights violations should be removed from their posts and brought to justice.

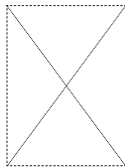
I also urge you to investigate the Law and Order section of the Criminal Investigations Department of the police, which is accused of torturing and otherwise ill-treating hundreds of human rights defenders and political activists.
