Amnesty International has learned that the death sentence brought against Nasr Hassan Bashir Nasr, a former official of the Sudanese embassy in Saudi Arabia, in May 1992 was commuted to life imprisonment on 16 February 1993. Nasr Hassan Bashir Nasr was arrested in December 1991 on allegations of spying (see UA 09/92, AFR 54/01/92 of 8 January 1992).

Zaki Hassan Bahsir Nasr, Fadul Sultan Karkola and Mohamedein Suleiman Bakheit have been sentenced to terms of imprisonment, ranging from five to seven years.
