The amount of appeals generated by this web action prompted the Sudanese authorities to respond to Amnesty International regarding this case. An investigation has now been opened - however, there are fears that it may be delayed or subject to interference by security forces.

Abu Nigel El Amin, Juma Mahamoud and Ramadan Ismail remain living in the town of Dongola. Juma Omar El-Nur, having received treatment for his injuries sustained under torture, has resumed his job as a tailor.
