## SUDAN Ghazi Suleiman (m), aged 63, Chair of the Sudan Human Rights Group Mohammed Alhafiz (m), Deputy Chair of the Sudan Human Rights Group Min-Allah Eissa (m), Trade Union leader

Ghazi Suleiman, the Chair of the Sudan Human Rights Group and a leader of the political party National alliance for the Restoration of Democracy (NARD), was released on 15 July. He had been detained incommunicado for almost two weeks in the section of Khartoum's Kober prison run by the security forces. He stated that he was well-treated in detention. He refused to sign an undertaking that he would renounce his political activities.

Mohamed Alhafiz, Vice-Chair of the Sudan Human Rights Group, and Min-Allah Eissa, a trade union leader, have been told they no longer have to report to the offices of the National Security Forces on a daily basis.
