Amnesty International remains concerned that Seif Sharif Hamad and the others named above could be arrested at any time, and tried together with 18 CUF prisoners of conscience charged with treason. However, contrary to what the Attorney General told reporters on 16 September, Zanzibar police say that no warrants for their arrests have been issued.

No further action is requested from the Urgent Action network at this time. Thank you for your appeals, which successfully alerted the authorities in Zanzibar and mainland Tanzania to the continuing international concern about this serious human rights issue in Zanzibar. Amnesty International will be monitoring the case closely.
