On 12 November 1999, Lambert Djunga Shango, Pierre Risasi, Okumbo and Dada Feza Rukeratabaro were acquitted due to insufficient evidence.

Amnesty International has no further information, however, of the other five sentenced to death by the *Cour d'ordre Militaire* (COM), Military Order Court on 19 October after it found them guilty of stealing fuel from the military.

The organization is concerned that the court's proceedings have consistently contravened international standards for fair trial and that its statute, which prohibits appeal to a higher jurisdiction, leaves defendants with no opportunity to challenge convictions and sentences.

Many thanks to all who sent appeals on behalf of the four acquitted.

Appeals on behalf of the other five still under sentence of death may continue as before by email/express/airmail letters in french or in your own language:

- urging President Kabila to spare the lives of Bukasa Musenga, Gaby Ngimbi Kiamba, Muzaliwa Maroy, Issa Yuba and Onza Kanda and to order a halt to further sentences of death;
- asking the authorities to respect their assurances to abolish the $\it Cour d' ordre militaire$ and the death penalty.
