The oral public proceedings scheduled on 31 October 1995 of the trial concerning the killing of Diego Rodríguez Laguens were cancelled before they started. Amnesty International has now received information indicating that a new date has been set for the trial, which is due to begin on 22 March 1996. The organization remains concerned for the safety of the relatives of the victim, who are also the main witnesses, Felipe Rodríguez Laguens, Pedro Rodríguez Laguens and Barbara Rodríguez Laguens, brothers and sister of the deceased, as well as that of the family lawyer, Dr Federico Huber and the forensic expert, Miguel Angel Maldonado.

Amnesty International is concerned that the above mentioned who are all involved in trying to clarify the circumstances of Diego Rodríguez Laguens' death have been subjected to death threats and intimidation. The police and judicial investigations procedures have allegedly been hampered by members of the Jujuy police. The participation of the Federal Police instead of the Provincial Police in court security is still required.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or in your own language:

- recognizing the trial as a positive development in the clarification of the death of Diego Rodríguez Laguens and welcoming the steps taken to determine responsibility;
- seeking assurances that during the trial the lawyers and forensic experts will be allowed to perform their role and the witnesses be allowed to testify without fear of intimidation;
- urging that the safety of the relatives and witnesses be adequately guaranteed;
- requesting that steps be taken to allow for the participation fo the Federal Police in court security and the protection of witnesses and relatives.
