BRAZILWagner DOS SANTOS, aged 23, witness to the "Candelaria Massacre"

Amnesty International has learned with concern that, because of fears for his safety, Wagner Dos Santos cannot leave the hospital where he has been treated after the attempt against his life in December 1994.

On the night of 9 December, Wagner dos Santos, a key witness to the killing of eight street children in Rio de Janeiro in July 1993, was found unconscious near Rio de Janeiro's main railway station, *Central do Brasil*. He had several bullet wounds, allegedly inflicted by a group of plainclothes police officers. Seriously ill, Wagner was taken to the Firemen's Hospital, where he was placed under police and hospital staff protection.

On 5 January, Wagner was discharged from hospital. However, he could not leave as the state authorities would not provide him adequate protection and an alternative shelter. The hospital authorities reported that in mid-January they received an anonymous telephone call threatening to abduct Wagner from the hospital. The hospital authorities stress that they are not able to keep Wagner in hospital much longer, as they need his bed for other patients. Wagner still needs major surgery to treat facial paralysis brought on by the bullet wounds. There is apparently no public hospital currently able to perform this operation.

To Amnesty International's knowledge, nobody has yet been charged with Wagner dos Santos' abduction and shooting.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters

calling on the authorities to guarantee the physical safety of Wagner dos Santos and provide him with all necessary protection, including the provision of safe accommodation, so that he can leave hospital safely;
expressing concern at the apparent lack of progress in the investigation on the abduction and shooting of Wagner Dos Santos on 9 December 1994.
