Amnesty International remains seriously concerned for the safety of inhabitants of the municipality of El Carmen del Atrato, department of Chocó. There is particular concern for Sister Elsa María Rueda, a nun and member of the *Comité de Derechos Humanos del Carmen del Atrato*, the Human Rights Committee of El Carmen del Atrato, who has reportedly been threatened.

According to information received, in a meeting held on 16 June 1996 between members of the *Comando de la IV Brigada de Antioquia*, Command of the IV Brigade of Antioquia, *Comando Operativo del Ejército de Chocó*, Chocó Operations Command of the Army, the mayor of the municipality and members of the *Equipo del Pastoral Parroquial*, Parish Pastoral Team, Sister Elsa María Rueda was accused by military commanders of taking supplies to guerrilla forces. In the past those labelled guerrilla sympathizers or collaborators by the security forces have frequently become the victims of human rights violations at the hands of the security forces themselves or their paramilitary allies. Elsa María Rueda has also reportedly been threatened by members of the Colombian army.

The threats against Elsa María Rueda have been made in a context of increasing intimidation of the civilian population of El Carmen del Atrato and neighbouring municipalities in the departments of Chocó and Antioquia, which coincide with an increasing presence of paramilitary groups in the region.

On 17 June three students were reportedly accused by armed forces personnel of being "guerrilla collaborators", raising fears for their safety. Although the students have not been formally charged. The army demanded that their school hand over their curriculum vitae.

Please continue action as outlined in original UA, especially continuing to call for immediate steps to ensure the safety of the civilian population in El Carmen del Atrato and neighbouring municipalities.

expressing particular concern for the safety of Sister Elsa María Rueda, who has reportedly been subjected to threats and labelled as a guerrilla collaborator by members of the security forces;
