The six mayors of Antioquia department, and human rights adviser Pedro Chica, have been released safe and well.

They were reportedly handed over to a delegation of the International Committee of the Red Cross in Colombia, in an area of northeastern Antioquia.

They had been abducted on 18 November by members of the army-backed paramilitary group *Bloque Metro Autodefensas Unidas de Colombia* (AUC), Metro Bloc of the Self-Defence Groups of Colombia.

In a press release the mayors announced that they had suspended their talks with the armed opposition group *Ejército de Liberación Nacional* (ELN), National Liberation Army, because it was clear that their security could not be guaranteed.
