Insufficient medical care for Jorge Luis García Pérez [Antúnez] Cuba

[original action AMR 25/003/2001, 26 April 2001]

Key words ill-health / insufficient medical care / hunger strike

Amnesty International welcomes reports that Jorge Luis García Pérez (also called Antúnez) stopped his hunger strike on 27 April 2001, because he was visited by a specialist chest physician. It is not clear what further treatment, if any, he has received.

Jorge Luis García Pérez was reportedly transferred to Camilo Cienfuegos Hospital in Sancti Spíritus in February 2001 where, according to reports, it was discovered that he had a mass in his lung. In addition, he was said to be suffering from kidney problems, severe weight loss, frequent fainting, vomiting and was coughing up blood. Since his hospital visit in February 2001 he had apparently not received any treatment until recently.

Jorge Luis García Pérez, aged 36, was sentenced on charges of "enemy propaganda", "attempted sabotage", illegal possession of a weapon and attempted escape. He has been imprisoned since 15 March 1990 and is currently held in Nieves Morejón prison in Sancti Spíritus Province. His total combined sentence is 18 years' imprisonment.

Recommended actions

We would like to ask the Ecuador, Mexico and Canadian (English speaking) health professional groups to write further appeals. No further appeals are requested at the moment from other groups.

Please write letters, preferably in Spanish:

welcoming reports that Jorge Luis García Pérez, imprisoned in Camilo Cienfuegos Hospital in Sancti Spíritus, was visited by a specialist chest physician; asking the authorities for details of his current state of health; asking for details of medical care he is receiving and of medical services available in prison.

If you receive no reply from the government or other recipients within two months of dispatch of your letter, please send a follow up letter seeking a response. Please check with the medical team if you are sending appeals after 30 June 2001, and send copies of any replies you do receive to the International Secretariat (att: medical team).
