# GUATEMALAMaría Francisca Ventura Sican (f), human rights defender Mildred Saquic (f) 8-year-old daughter

On 26 November 1997 at 10pm, María Francisca Ventura Sican and her eight-year-old daughter, Mildred Saquic were sitting at home, when shots were fired from outside. One of the shots grazed Mildred Saquic's arm, wounding her slightly. In the days leading up to the attack, several unidentified men in army uniforms visited Maria Francisca Ventura's father's house and asked for her.

This incident follows a series of threats and acts of intimidation against María Francisca and her family in April and May 1997, carried out by individuals presumed to be members of the security forces or those acting on their behalf It is believed that these threats were related to Maria Francisca Ventura giving testimony to Amnesty International delegates who visited the country in April 1997.

María Francisca Ventura is the widow of evangelical pastor Manuel Saquic Vásquez, whose body was found in an unmarked grave on 7 July 1995. He was coordinator of a Kaqchikel Maya Human Rights Committee in Panajabal, Chimaltenango Department. He"disappeared" after being abducted by alleged members of the security forces on 23 June 1995. Residents of Panajabal believe that Manuel Saquic was killed in reprisal for his human rights work and because he was also the sole witness to the abduction by security forces of another member of the Human Rights Committee in Panajabal.

María Francisca Ventura, her relatives and other human rights defenders have been pressing for those responsible for Manuel Saquic's death to be brought to justice. As a result of their efforts, they have been subjected to a number of threats. To date those responsible for the killing of her husband and the threats against her, her family and those working on Manuel Saquic's case, have not been brought to justice.

## FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/ airmail letters in Spanish or in your own language:

- expressing serious concern about the latest attack against María Francisca Ventura and her family;

- expressing concern for the safety of María Francisca Ventura and family and calling on the authorities to take immediate measures to guarantee their safety;

- calling on the authorities to conduct full and prompt investigations into the intimidation, harassment and previous death threats and to ensure that those responsible are brought to justice.

- urging that those responsible for killing Manuel Saquic are brought to justice without further delay.
