Amnesty International has learned that Moïse Paul, Coordinator of the Union of Young Patriots of Drouillard, has been released. He had been detained on 16 July 1994 in Cité Soleil, a slum on the outskirts of Port-au-Prince. He was reportedly ill-treated by *attachés* (armed auxiliaries to the security forces) whilst in detention.

Emile Georges remains "disappeared". It is believed that he may also have been detained in Cité Soleil on 18 July 1994 by the security forces. Amnesty International is concerned for his safety, particularly since two other members of the *Plateforme des organisations Populaires de la Cité Soleil* have been killed in the past, possibly victims of extrajudicial execution. The two men concerned were Rigaud Pierre, killed on 9 March 1993 and Marc-Aurel Laurent, killed on 9 April 1994.

**FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please telephone/send telegrams, telexes and faxes\* in French, English or your own language:**

- expressing concern about the continued "disappearance" of Emile Georges;
- urging that his whereabouts be immediately clarified;
- urging that if he has been detained, his physical security be guaranteed and that he be granted access to a lawyer, a doctor and relatives;
- asking that he be charged with a recognisable criminal offence or else released immediately;
- expressing concern about the alleged ill-treatment of Moïse Paul whilst held in detention and that those responsible be brought to justice.
