### UA 86/98 Fear for safety/ Possible extrajudicial execution 17 March 1998

## MEXICO Members of the OCSS

Amnesty International is seriously concerned for the safety of members of the Southern Sierra Peasant Organisation, *Organización Campesina Sierra del Sur* (OCSS), following the death of one of their leaders on 15 March 1998. Santiago Luna Reina was gunned down by an unidentified group of heavily armed masked men near the town of Tepetixtla, Guerrero State. Amnesty fears that OCSS members may be subjected to further human rights violations by both members of the security forces and paramilitary groups acting with the complicity of the authorities.

Witnesses have reported that the attack was carried out by paramilitary groups with strong links to the *Partido Revolucionario Institucional* (PRI), Institutional Revolutionary Party, the ruling party in Mexico.

Members of the OCSS have frequently been targeted by the security forces in Guerrero State, on unfounded grounds that the organisation is linked to the *Ejército Popular Revolucionario* (EPR), Revolutionary Popular Army, an armed opposition group operating in the region. The EPR came into force in June 1996, in the states of Guerrero and Oaxaca, on the first anniversary of a massacre in which 17 people were killed, many of them members of the OCSS.

Dozens of human rights violations, including extrajudicial execution, "disappearance" and torture, have been carried out against members of the OCSS. The perpetrators have been allowed to act with total impunity.

calling for an immediate investigation to be opened into the killing of Santiago Luna Reina and for those responsible to be brought to justice;
requesting that measures be taken by the authorities to guarantee the safety of all members of the Organización Campesina Sierra del Sur (OCSS), Southern Sierra Peasant Organisation;

- expressing alarm at the number of cases of gross human rights violations carried out against members of the OCSS, reportedly by members of the security forces as well as paramilitary groups.
