Amnesty International's fears for the safety of the Indian peasant community in Chapopote Chico have widened into concern for Indian peasants across the whole State of Veracruz. Latest reports indicate that one man has been shot dead by police and others have been arrested amidst reports of police ill-treatment.

On 18 August 1995 in Chapopote Chico, members of the *Judicial y Seguridad Publica del Estado*, Judicial Police and Public Security, of Veracruz state arrested Silvestre Hernández del Angel, Urcino Aquino and another unidentified person. Children and old people are reported to have been ill-treated during the police operation.

Also on 18 August, 400 members of the Judicial Police and Public Security, together with some hired gunmen, are reported to have raided Cantollano community, in Ixhuatlán district, state of Veracruz. Eye-witnesse report that Nicolas Hernández Hernández, a 24-year-old Indian peasant activist, was shot and killed by members of the security forces as he was running, frightened, towards his house after having seen the security forces approaching. Sixteen other people, listed above, were reportedly arrested by the security forces. There is concern for their safety in detention.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or in your own language:

- calling for a prompt and full investigation into the killing of Nicolas Hernández Hernández, during a police operation against the Cantollano community, in Ixhuatlán district, state of Veracruz, on 18 August 1995; seeking assurances that all detainees arrested in Chapopote Chico and Ixhuatlán (name some of them) are being humanely treated amd that they are being allowed inmediately access to relatives, doctors, interpreters and lawyers;
- calling for all the detainees to be immediately released unless they are to be charged with recognizably criminal offences;
- reiterating concern for the safety of all Indian peasants in Veracruz state;
