The Centro de Derechos Humanos Miguel Agustín Pro Juárez, A.C., (PRODH), Human Rights Centre Miguel Agustín Pro Juarez, has reported the apparent end of the surveillance operation being carried out on the organization and its members by 20 armed men since 5 May 1997.

The authorities have provided the offices of the PRODH with a security guard. An investigation into the surveillance operation is reportedly underway.

In a communication received by Amnesty International the PRODH expressed its thanks for the solidarity shown over the events of recent days by people and organizations in Mexico and abroad, " El Centro agradece la solidaridad que en estos días diversas personas y organizaciones en México y en el extranjero han expresado por estos hechos".
