Latest reports indicate that Teodoro Juárez Sánchez has been tortured in prison in Acapulco, Guerrero state, by other inmates working with the knowledge of the prison authorities, in order to silence his demands for justice. He has had to be hospitalized as a result.

Teodoro Juárez Sánchez, a member of the *Organización Campesina de la Sierra del Sur* (OCSS), Southern Sierra Peasant Organization, was arrested on 8 July 1996 in Yerbasantita, Guerrero state, together with other three OCSS members. He was reportedly tortured for several days in unacknowledged detention, before being taken before a judge in Acapulco. He testified that the state police had beaten him, subjected him to electric shocks and held his head under water in order to force him to confess to being a member of the *Ejército Revolucionario Popular* (ERP), People's Revolutionary Army. To date there has been no investigation into his allegations and no-one has been brought to justice.

Amnesty International has no further information about the other detainees named above. In view of the reports concerning Teodoro Juárez Sánchez, the organization remains concerned for the safety of any of those who remain in detention.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters either in Spanish or in your own language:

- expressing deep concern that Teodoro Juárez Sánchez has had to be hospitalized as a result of torture, and urging that he receive all the medical treatment that he requires and that he not be returned to prison until fully recovered; calling for immediate, full and impartial investigations into the alleged torture and for those responsible to be brought to justice;
- calling for immediate measures to ensure that any other peasant activists arrested around the same time who remain in detention are protected from torture and ill-treatment;

if possible also:

- ask what action the authorities took in response to earlier appeals about the torture of Hilario Mesino Acosta (see previous update) and other peasant activists arrested in July;
- call for immediate and effective measures to end the impunity currently being enjoyed by perpetrators of human rights violations in Mexico.
