On 30 September 1997, the bodies of Angel Leal Alonso, Román Morales Acevedo and Carlos Alberto López Inés were discovered near a road south of Mexico City. They were in a condition which made it impossible to immediately identify them. However, members of their respective families confirmed that the clothes on the bodies corresponded to the clothes worn by the three young men the day they "disappeared".

This follows the earlier discovery of the bodies of Daniel Colín Enciso, Oscar Iván Mora and Juan Carlos Romero Peralta on 9 September. They had evidently been tortured before being shot, at close range, in the head.

The Asamblea Legislativa del Distrito Federal, Legislative Assembly of the Federal District, has announced that it will create a commission to follow and ensure that investigations lead to the identification and punishment of those responsible for these killings.
