Amnesty International has learned that Raymond Kinnamon, who was scheduled to be executed by the state of Texas, USA, on 2 March 1992, was granted a stay of execution. The reason for the stay is unknown. No further appeals are required on his behalf at the moment.

Edward Ellis was executed as scheduled, on 3 March 1992.
