Imminent execution warrants have been issued by the state of Texas, USA, to the above named prisoners. This brings the total number of prisoners scheduled to be executed by the state of Texas over the next six weeks to 10. (Leonel Herrera, Delma Banks, and Joseph Faulder are scheduled to be executed in Texas on 15 April, 30 April, and 6 May 1992 respectively. See further information EXTRA 50/91, AMR 51/45/92, 31 March; further information EXTRA 25/92, AMR 51/44/92, 30 March 1992; further information EXTRA 02/92, AMR 51/40/92, 17 March 1992).

Information regarding the seven prisoners is as follows:

Benjamin BOYLE, white, sentenced to death 30 October 1986 for the murder of a white woman: scheduled to be executed 16 April 1992.

David GIBBS, white, sentenced to death 20 March 1986 for the murder of a white woman: scheduled to be executed 19 April 1992.

Billy WHITE, black, sentenced to death 25 October 1977 for the murder of a white woman: scheduled to be executed 23 April 1992.

Harold LANE, white, sentenced to death 11 May 1983 for the murder of a white woman: scheduled to be executed 24 April 1992.

Lester BOWER, white, sentenced to death 28 April 1984 for the murder of four white males: scheduled to be executed 29 April 1992.

Ricardo GUERRA, hispanic, sentenced to death 4 October 1982 for the murder of a white male: scheduled to be executed 12 May 1992.

James EARHART, no further information available: scheduled to be executed 12 May 1992.

As of December 1991, there were 345 prisoners under sentence of death in Texas. The last person to be executed in the state was Edward Ellis, on 3 March 1992. Execution in Texas is carried out by lethal injection.

Amnesty International opposes the death penalty as a violation of the right to life and the right not to be subjected to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Amnesty International is extremely concerned about the high rate of executions in the United States of America this year. In the first three months of 1992 ten prisoners have been executed in the USA, as against 14 in the whole of 1991.

## RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes and telephone calls:

- urging the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles to convene a clemency hearing to consider the cases of Benjamin Boyle, David Gibbs, Billy White, Harold Lane, Lester Bower, Ricardo Guerra and James Earhart;
- appealing to them to recommend that Governor Richards grant clemency to them by commuting their death sentences.
