USA (Texas)Charles Anthony Boyd, aged 39

Charles Boyd was executed in Texas on 5 August 1999. He had been sentenced to death in November 1987 for the capital murder of Mary Milligan.

According to reports, Boyd initially declined to make a final statement. However, as the lethal injection began he said: "I want you all to know I did not do this crime. I asked for a 30-day stay for a DNA test so you know who did the crime."

Four of Mary Milligan's relatives were among those who witnessed the execution.

Charles Boyd becomes the 18^{th} person executed in Texas in 1999, and the 182^{nd} overall since executions resumed in the state in December 1982.

He also became the 61^{st} person executed in the USA this year and the 561^{st} overall since the USA resumed executions in 1977.
