**Joseph Timothy Keel (m), white, aged 39**

Joseph Timothy (Timmy) Keel was executed in North Carolina on 7 November. He was sentenced to death at a retrial in 1993 for the murder of his father-in-law, John Simmons, who was shot on his farm in 1990.

Governor Mike Easley denied clemency on the evening of 6 November. He said: "Having carefully reviewed the clemency petition, I find no compelling reasons to invalidate the sentence recommended by two juries and affirmed by the courts".

Timmy Keel becomes the 60<sup>th</sup> person to be executed in the USA this year, and the 880<sup>th</sup> since the country resumed judicial killing in 1977. North Carolina accounts for 28 of these executions.
