Freddy Diaz, aged 18, killed

The family of Freddy Diaz, shot dead in the municipality of Sucre on 8 July 1998, reportedly by a policeman, continue to live in fear as a result of persistent and ongoing harassment and intimidation by members of the Sucre police force. Fear for their safety therefore remains.

The police are maintaining intensive surveillance of Yolima Rangel's home involving the regular presence of police cars passing slowly in front of the house throughout the day and night.

Furthermore, the court case against the policeman accused of shooting Freddy Diaz has been delayed by the *Policía Técnica Judicial* (PTJ), Criminal Investigation Police.

Immediately following the killing of Freddy Diaz, his family were taken into custody for 24 hours and told by police that if they pressed charges they would: "hacerles la vida imposible", "make your lives impossible".

Yolima Rangel nevertheless reported the shooting, resulting in police harrassment to both her and her neighbours.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or in your own language:

expressing concern for the safety of Yolima Rangel and her family, who continue to live in fear as a result of ongoing and persistant harrassment by the Sucre police force, and calling on the authorities to guarantee their safety;
calling for a full and impartial investigation into the events surrounding the death of Freddy Diaz, and calling for those responsible to be brought to justice;

- reminding the government of Venezuela of its commitment to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, in particular Article 3: "Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person."
